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<p><b>Educational and other qualifications required for direct recruits.-</b></p> <p><b><u>Essential</u></b> Graduation/Bachelor degree from a recognized University.</p> <p><b><u>Desirable qualification:-</u></b> Masters Degree in Criminology, Sociology, Social Work, Law or Psychology.</p> <p><b>Physical standard [for male]</b> Height: <b>165 cms, Relaxable by 5 cms</b> for residents of hill areas i.e., Garhwalis, Kumaonis, Gorkhas, Dogras, Marathas and candidates belonging to States of Sikkim, Nagaland, Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur, Tripura, Mizoram, Meghalaya, Assam, Himachal Pradesh, Kashmir and Leh &amp; Ladakh regions of J&amp;K (Candidates claiming this relaxation would have to produce a certificate to this effect (<b>Hill area certificate</b>) from the competent authority i. e., DC/DM/SDM or Tehsildar of their place of residence with the application and at the time of Physical Measurement Test). <b>Chest:</b> Minimum 81 cms – 85 cms (with minimum of 4 cms expansion). Relaxable by 5cms for residents of hill areas, for which certificate as above will be produced.</p> <p><b>Physical standard [for female]</b> Height: <b>157 cms, Relaxable by 5 cms</b>, for residents of hill areas i.e., Garhwalis, Kumaonis, Gorkhas, Dogras, Marathas and candidates belonging to States of Sikkim, Nagaland, Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur, Tripura, Mizoram, Meghalaya, Assam, Himachal Pradesh, Kashmir and Leh &amp; Ladakh regions of J&amp;K (Candidates claiming this relaxation would have to produce a certificate to this effect (<b>Hill area certificate</b>) from the competent authority i. e., DC/DM/SDM or Tehsildar of their place of residence with the application and at the time of Physical Measurement Test).</p> <p><b>Physical Endurance Test (PET) [for male]:</b> 1600 meters race in 06 (six) minutes and 30 seconds <b>Note 1 :</b> Those who qualify in the race shall be further eligible to appear in the following tests :- (i) High jump – 3' 6" (To be achieved in any one of the three chances that will be given). (ii) Broad jump/Long jump – 13.0 feet (To be achieved in any one of the three chances that will be given).</p> <p><b>Physical Endurance Test (PET) [for female]:</b> 800 meters race in 4 (four) minutes and 30 seconds. <b>Note :</b> Those who qualify in the race shall be further eligible to appear in the following tests :- (i) High jump – 3.00 feet (To be achieved in any one of the three chances that will be given). (ii) Broad jump/Long jump – 9.0 feet (To be achieved in any one of the three chances that will be given). <b>Medical Standard:</b> (i) The minimum distant vision should be 6/6 in better eye and 6/12 in the worse eye, without glasses. The candidate should be free from colour blindness. (ii) The candidate must not have knock knee, flat foot, varicose vein or squint in eyes. (iii) The candidate should be in good mental and bodily health and free from any physical defect likely to interfere with the efficient performance of the duties.</p> <p><b>Note-2 :</b> There would be no appeal against the PET.</p>	<p>Age:- N.A.</p> <p><b><u>Education Qualification:-</u></b> Yes</p> <p>Note: For the officials, who are holding feeder grade post as on date of this notification, qualification of 10<sup>th</sup> Pass from recognized Board or equivalent will be essential for promotion.</p>

(ii) Head Warders/ Head Matrons who do not come in the category (i) but have put together 15 years regular service as Warder/Head Warder or Matron / Head Matron. Out of 15 years, 07 years should be regular service as Head Warder/Head Matron. <b>Note:</b> The ratio of Head Warder and Head Matron shall be "proportionate to sanctioned strength of the feeder post". <b>Deputation:-</b> Officials of CAPFs:- (i) Holding analogous post on regular basis in the parent cadre/department, or (ii) With 7(seven) years of service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on regular basis in the level-5 (Rs.29200-Rs.92300) of Pay Matrix in the parent cadre/department, who are engaged in maintenance of Law and Order and security duties etc.</p> <p><b>Note 1:-</b> Where juniors who have completed their qualifying/eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their seniors would also be considered provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying/eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying/eligibility service or two years, whichever is less, and have successfully completed probation period for promotion to the next higher grade along with their juniors who have already completed such qualifying/eligibility service.</p>	<p><b>Group 'B' DPC (for promotion/confirmation)</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Secretary-cum-Commissioner (Development) - <b>Chairman.</b></li> <li>Administrative Secretary of the Department concerned – <b>Member.</b></li> <li>Special/Addl. 		<p><b>Note2:-</b> The departmental officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by deputation. Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion. Period of deputation/contract in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization/department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not be exceed 03 years.</p> <p><b>Note 3:-</b> The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall be, not exceeding 56 years, as on the closing date of receipts of applications.</p> <p><b>(However, proposed deputation by CAPF/Police to be vetted by the Law Deptt. with respect to permissibility under law/statues governing prisons, (which comes under judicial purview).</b></p>		
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**Notes:-**

1. The age limit for direct recruitment will be relaxable in the case of Scheduled Castes/Tribes candidates and other special category of persons in accordance with the general orders issued from time to time by the Central Government.
2. Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations and other concessions required to be provided for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of person in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Govt. from time to time in this regard.
3. No male candidate who has more than one wife living or no female candidate who has married a person already having a wife living shall be eligible for appointment in case of direct recruitment provided that the Administrator, Delhi, may after being satisfied that there are special grounds for doing so, exempt any such candidate from the operation of this rule.
4. Where the Administrator is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order for reasons to be recorded in writing relax any of the provisions of the rules with respect to a class or category of persons/posts.
