NOTIFICATION

F. No. F.9/125/2006-Home(G) .- In exercise of the powers conferred by proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India read with the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs notification No.F.27/59-Min (H) dated the 13th July, 1959, and in supersession of the notification No.F.2(1)/74-S2 dated the 3rd June, 1994 except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the Lt. Governor of the National Capital Territory of Delhi, is pleased to make rules regarding the method of recruitment for the post of **DEPUTY SUPERINTENDENT**, in the Delhi Prisons Department, Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi, as following, namely :-

1. **Short title and commencement** – (1) These rules may be called the Deputy Superintendent Central Jail, Recruitment Rules 2014.
 (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official Gazette.
2. **Number of post, its classification, pay band and grade pay/scale of pay.** - The number of said post, its classification, pay band and grade pay/scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 to the Schedule annexed to these rules.
3. **Method of Recruitment, age limit, qualification etc.** - The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post, shall be as specified in the columns 5 to 13 of the said Schedule.

Disqualifications.- No Person,-

(a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living : or

(b) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

Shall be eligible for the appointment to the said post :

Provided that the Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from operation of this rule.

Power to Relax.- Where the Government is of opinion that if necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, may relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of person.

Saving.- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxations of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Ex-Servicemen, Other Backward Classes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

<p>Promotion:- Deputy Superintendent Grade-II with five years of service in the grade after appointment thereto on a regular basis in the Pay Band-II, Rs.9,300-34,800 plus Grade Pay of Rs.4,200/-.</p> <p><u>Note-1:</u> Where juniors who have completed their qualifying or eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their seniors would also be considered provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying or eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying or eligibility service or two years, whichever is less and have successfully completed their probation period for promotion to the next higher grade alongwith their juniors who have already completed such qualifying or eligibility service.</p> <p><u>Note -2 :</u> For the purpose of computing minimum qualifying service for promotion, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to 1st January of 2006, the date from which the revised pay structure based on the 6th Central Pay Commission recommendations has been extended, shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding pay or pay scale extended based on the recommendations of the pay commission.</p> <p>Deputation (ISTC): Officers of Central Government/ State Government / Union Territories:- (A)(I) Holding analogous post on regular basis in the parent cadre/department, or (II) With five years service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on regular basis in PB-II Rs.9300-34800/- with Grade Pay Rs.4200/- in the parent cadre / department, and (B) possessing the following Educational Qualification and experience- (I) Degree of a recognized University. deputationist shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion. Period of deputation / contract including period of deputation / contract in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization/department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not to exceed 4 years.

Note-2:- The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation (ISTC) shall be, not exceeding 56 years, as on the closing date of receipt of applications.
