E. Age-wise population of prisoners

Majority of the Prison population around 54% were in the age group of 21-30 years. Next come the prisoners in the age group of 30-50 years which is around 32%. Around 0.92% of prisoners were more than 65 years of age. The figures further demonstrate that criminality in male offender was dominant in the age group of 21-30 years while in the female offender it was maximum in the age group of 30-50 years (because of dowry related offences). The Prison administration regularly takes up the cases of seriously sick and aged prisoners with the concerned trial courts so that if the court considers it fit they can be released on bail. The age-wise classification of undertrial and convicted prisoners is depicted in the table-E1 & E2 below:-
