

# F. Recidivism during the year 2010

Around 22% of the both convicts and undertrials population are repeaters / habituanale population of convicts around 20.59% were repeaters whereas amongst the fewas 16.14%. Similarly from the undertrial population around 22% were repeaters female population around 23% were repeaters. This mean 78% of the total prison time offenders.

#### 7. Offence wise population of prisoners

#### A. Undertrials:-

The undertrial population is divided into two categories:- one comprises undertrials who are facing charges under Indian Penal Code (IPC) and others who are facing charges under Local and Special Act Cases. (L&SACases).

There has been increase in the number of male prisoners facing trial in IPC offences. In the year 2009 it was 80.71% whereas in the year 2010 it was 83.56% of the total population showing an increase of 2.85%. However, there is decline in the prison population in the Local and Special Law category which has declined from 19.27% in year 2009 to 16.44% showing a decline of 2.83%.

The analysis & comparison of this years male prisoners profile with that of year 2009 shows that in IPC cases there is slight increase in the murder and theft cases (2.74% and 2.25% respectively) while dacoity shows decline by 3.40% and in other cases there is negligible variation (less than 1%). The profile of female shows that there is increase in cheating cases by 4.94%, theft cases 4.71%, Kidnapping and abduction act by 2.65% and in rape cases by 2.47%.

In Local and Special Law categories there is decline in the Arms Act and NDPS Act cases (1.03% and 0.38% respectively) while dowry prohibition act shows increase by 0.79%. of male prisoners. The profile of female prisoners shows that there is decrease of prisoners in dowry prohibition act by 6.88% and NDPS cases by 0.46% while there is slight variation in other cases.

# **B.** Convicts

In the male prisoner population convicts constituted 25.57% (2647) and amongst females convicts constituted 20.59% (104). The average convict prisoners population in Delhi Prisons in the year 2009 was 20.21% whereas in the year 2010 it has been 25.34%, thus an increase of 4.56% over the last year. The convict population is divided into two categories, one comprising convicts who have been convicted under Indian Penal Code (IPC) and others who are convicted under Local and Special Act Cases
