
3. TRENDS OF OVERCROWDING

The prison population as on 31.12.2012 has decreased by 0.09% in comparison to the population as on 31.12.2011. The decrease in this year population is because of decrease in undertrial population by 0.27%. Percentage wise there is decrease in undertrial population by 0.27% and increase in convict population by 0.37% in comparison to last year population.

• In year 2011, occupancy of prisons vis-à-vis sanctioned capacity was 194% and no major change was observed in the year-2012.

The trend of overcrowding of Delhi Prisons during the preceding 10 years is depicted in the graph below:



4. PRISONER'S PROFILE

PRISON POPULATION CATEGORY WISE AS ON 31.12.2012.

As on 31.12.2012 there were 8887 (73.37%) undertrials, 3219 (26.57%) convicts and detenues & others 7 (0.06%) as compare to 8911 (73.50%) undertrials, 3207 (26.45%) convicts, 6 (0.05%) detenues & others respectively. Gender wise prison population as on 31.12.2012 is shown in table below:

- The figure includes 398 foreign prisoners majority of whom were from Nigeria (161), Nepal (77), Bangladesh (51), Pakistan (24) and Afganistan (24) etc.
- The national average of undertrial prisoners in Indian jails was 64.70%* and in Delhi the percentage of undertrial population was 73.37%, much above the national average.
