STANDING ORDER NO. 28

Sub: Campus placement of prisoners.

A scheme of rehabilitation of prisoners has been initiated in Delhi Prisons by organizing Campus Placements, in coordination with different corporate houses. There is an urgent need for laying down a policy for short-listing candidates for such placements. Henceforth, the following shall be the criteria for selection of prisoners for participation in campus placements:-

- (a) This will be admissible only for convicts.
- (b) Prisoners involved in offences against the State, terrorist activities, MCOCA, NSA, PSA and otherwise involved in multiple heinous offences such as robbery, dacoity, murder, kidnapping for ransom etc., habitual jail rules offenders, who are frequently involved in assaulting co-inmates in the prison, shall not ordinarily be eligible for this facility. Prisoners having unbroken track record of good conduct since admission in prison should preferably be selected.
- (c) Prisoners who utilized their time in prison in educating themselves or in acquiring a vocational skill with requisite qualification prescribed for a particular job at the time of admission should be shortlisted.
- (d) Prisoners expecting their release in the near future, preferably within the next six months, should only be considered.
- (e) Prisoners who have surrendered on time after availing parole/furlough may be included and given preference.

It should also be explained to the eligible prisoners that campus placements will not confer on them a right to seek bail or any other relief from Courts and an undertaking should be taken from them in writing to this effect.
